With its clean, contemporary styling, this bathroom project features acid etched glass to allow light through to the loo and shower and still add a sense of privacy. The walls have been beautifully finished in a waterproof, concrete Beton Cire finish adding luxury and texture to the room, without compromising on functionality.

Susanna adds: “Our clients adore the polished Beton Cire wall finish because it is particularly stunning and tactile and it creates an exciting contrast with the Perlado marble surfaces and flooring. But for me, it’s the finer details, which have really made this bathroom. In particular, the small shadow gap at floor level and around the architrave of the doors. This cleverly creates a seamless, finishing touch.”

Mark Taylor Design completed the look with various lighting solutions, which spread light evenly into every corner of this luxury, bespoke suite. From the large, square ceiling LED panels to the down-lights fitted into recesses in the walls, they have created a contemporary space, which feels tranquil, modern and inviting.
