Having lived in London all their married lives, the couple and their three children, relocated to Surrey when they acquired this six-bedroom, four-bathroom 1940s home, which they decided to completely renovate and extend.

Managing director Mark Taylor explains: “Our clients wanted a large kitchen and entertaining space where the children could have their playroom and sitting area, leading into the dining area and then out to the garden. The kitchen needed to feel large but take up only enough room to allow the rest of the living area to feel spacious and fluid. In addition, the garden needed to be very accessible from the kitchen and dining area, as it also forms part of the living space during the summer months.”

The wife, who is Scandinavian, likes simple, light spaces and was keen to create a clean, uncluttered design. Both she and her husband enjoy entertaining and required plenty of space for storing and preparing fresh food, although they didn't want a long worktop run. "We changed the building plans to incorporate a walk-in larder and extra large, double-width fridge," explains Mark. "This allowed us to build the rest of the kitchen around these features. The space needed to be as free flowing as possible at worktop level and our clients were very keen to have a large island, which we used as the metamorphosis between the dining area and the kitchen."

The in-frame cock-beaded timber and oak kitchen with dovetail drawers is painted in Farrow & Ball's Pavilion Gray, which works beautifully with the Silestone Yukon worktops and large, natural stone tiles.

The clients, who are thrilled with the results, add: "We absolutely love our Mark Taylor Design kitchen, down to the last detail. Aside from the look, what we enjoy the most is the quality of the workmanship, which is outstanding."

Bespoke kitchens by Mark Taylor Design, excluding appliances and surfaces, start from £30,000.
